Thinking right is extremely important in every area of life. I realize I've said this numerous times.

Hebrews 11:6 AMP says

"But without faith it is impossible to [walk with God and] please Him, for whoever comes [near] to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He rewards those who [earnestly and diligently] seek Him."

Hebrews 11:6 KJV says

"But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."

A true Christian believes Gods Word is the truth.

John 14:6 KJV says,

"Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."
